Open House

- Ask questions and interact with resource area experts.
- Submit a comment form or provide oral comments to a typist.

Formal Public Hearing

- Provide oral comments. A stenographer and translator will be present.
- A moderator not related to the project will preside over the hearing.
- Verbal comments will be limited to three minutes to ensure there is time for everyone to be heard. After three minutes, speakers will be allowed to continue with a typist at the comment table.
